Guidelines

- Must be a Boone Co. Resident
- Residential Waste Only - No Business or Industrial Waste
- Stay in your vehicle @ the event for health & safety

Do NOT Bring:

- **Latex Paint**
Latex Paint is Non-Toxic & should be allowed to dry out (Cat Litter helps) until it is non-liquid, then place it in a trash bag in your residential curbside trash
- Radioactive Waste
- Explosives (i.e. Ammunition, Fireworks, Flares, Etc.)
- Alkaline Batteries (i.e. AA/AAA/C/D/are Non-Hazardous)
- Appliances

- Pesticides/Herbicides/Insecticides
- Household Cleaners
- Electronics (Free, with the exception of a **\$20 CASH fee per unit for ALL televisions & CRT monitors**)
- Aerosols
- Pool Chemicals
- Thermometers & Thermostats
- Batteries (Automobile & Rechargeable)
- **Tire Limits Per Primary Residence -**
4 Vehicle or Truck Tires
2 Tractor Tires
(Outside Diameter Max. 54")
Combination thereof (4 Tire Max.)
No Rims
