**OLD BUSINESS**

**ORDINANCE 2021-12 – AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA ESTABLISHING A LOCAL FUND FOR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE RECEIVED FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021. Attorney Rob Schein reads the Ordinance on second reading.**

*Motion by Councilmember Robertson to approve Ordinance 2021-12, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilmember Kincaid. Motion carries by a unanimous vote.*

## NEW BUSINESS

**ORDINANCE 2021-15 – AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, BOONE COUNTY, INDIANA CONCERNING AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 77 – PARKING SCHEDULES.** Kevin Krulik, City Engineer explains the need to add one street, N. Clark St. from W. Williams to Chicago St. Attorney, Rob Schein reads the Ordinance on first reading.

*Motion by Councilmember Robertson to suspend the rules and move to second reading, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilmember Jones. Motion carries by a unanimous vote.*

*Motion by Councilmember Robertson to approve Ordinance 2021-15 on second reading for the amendment to parking schedule on the east side of N. Clark St. from W. Williams St. to Chicago St., 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilmember S. Messenger. Motion carries by a unanimous vote.*

**LETTER OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT: 2021 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Round COMMUNITY CROSSINGS GRANT PROGRAM.** Kevin Krulik, City Engineer explains Community Crossings applications are open and we have prepared a list of road resurfacing projects. We use the Pavements Asset Management Plan and the PASER System to choose which roads are most important from a maintenance standpoint and quality of pavement and level of traffic that weighs in on our decision. Kevin reads the list of 10 roads to be paved. He then discusses financing of this project noting the money wouldn't be spent until 2022. Discussion follows.

*Motion by Councilmember Kincaid to approve the Letter of Support up to \$1,000,000 and authorize the Mayor to sign, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilmember Jones. Motion carries by a unanimous vote.*

**ANNOUNCEMENT UPDATE: GRANT ST. –** Kevin Krulik tells the Council that the State has moved up our letting date for Grant St. and we will no longer be bidding

in late 2022 for 2023 but bidding early in 2022 for 2022 construction. Kevin discusses the finances for the project.

**FOOD & BEVERAGE REQUEST: LINCOLN'S LEBANON** – John Copeland explains the Food & Beverage Committee met with representative from Lincoln's Lebanon which is sponsored by the Boone County Historical Society they are requesting funds for the event to held on September 25, 26, 2021 at Lebanon Memorial Park. Many activities will take place for the public to observe. The Committee recommends \$1500 for this event. They would also like to place banners around town as a reminder of the event.

*Motion by Councilmember Copeland to award \$1500 to Lincoln's Lebanon, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilmember Kincaid. Motion carries by a unanimous vote.*
