

ORDINANCE FOR APPROPRIATIONS AND TAX RATES

Ord # 01-10 SUBSET FUND 4 (REV. 12/03)

ORIGINAL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY, CITY OR TOWN OF LEBANON, INDIANA; THAT FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE COUNTY, CITY OR TOWN GOVERNMENT AND ITS INSTITUTIONS FOR THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1902, THE SINS OF MONEY SHOWN ON BUDGET FORM 4-4 ARE HEREBY APPROPRIATED AND ORDERED SET APART OUT OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS HEREIN MANDATED FOR THE PURPOSE HEREIN SPECIFIED, SUBJECT TO THE LAWS GOVERNING THE SAME. SUCH SINS HEREIN APPROPRIATED SHALL BE HELD TO INCLUDE ALL EXPENDITURES AUTHORIZED TO BE MADE DURING THE YEAR, UNLESS OTHERWISE EXPRESSLY STIPULATED AND PROVIDED FOR BY LAW. IN ADDITION FOR THE PURPOSE OF RAISING REVENUE TO MEET THE NECESSARY EXPENSE OF COUNTY, CITY OR TOWN GOVERNMENT, TAX RATES ARE SHOWN ON BUDGET FORM 4-8 AND INCLUDED HEREIN. TWO(2) COPIES OF BUDGET FORMS 4-4 AND 4-8 FOR ALL FUNDS AND DEPARTMENTS ARE MADE A PART OF THE BUDGET REPORT AND SUBMITTED HEREWITH.

THIS IS HEREBY GIVEN THE TAPPAYERS OF COUNTY, CITY OR TOWN OF LEBANON, INDIANA, AT CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS ON AUGUST 27, 2001, AT 7:30 P.M. A.M./P.M. WILL CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE BUDGET. FOLLOWING THIS HEARING, ANY TEN OR MORE TAPPAYERS MAY OBJECT TO A BUDGET, TAX RATE, OR TAX LEVY BY FILING AN OBJECTION PETITION WITH THE PROPER OFFICERS OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION WITHIN SEVEN DAYS AFTER THE HEARING. THE OBJECTION PETITION MUST IDENTIFY THE PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET, TAX RATE, OR TAX LEVY THAT TAPPAYERS OBJECT TO. IF A PETITION IS FILED, THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION SHALL ADOPT WITH ITS BUDGET A FINDING CONCERNING THE OBJECTIONS FILED AND TESTIMONY PRESENTED. FOLLOWING THE AFOREMENTIONED HEARING, THE COUNCIL WILL MEET AT CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS ON SEPTEMBER 10TH, 2001 AT 7:30 P.M. A.M./P.M. TO ADOPT THE FOLLOWING BUDGET:

TAPPAYERS APPEARING AT THE HEARING SHALL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD. AFTER THE TAX LEVIES HAVE BEEN DETERMINED, FIXED BY THE APPROPRIATE GOVERNING BODY, AND THE TAX RATES PUBLISHED BY THE COUNTY AUDITOR, TEN OR MORE TAPPAYERS OBJECTING TO THE LEVIES MAY APPEAL TO THE STATE BOARD OF TAX COMMISSIONERS BY FILING A PETITION WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR. THE PETITION MUST BE FILED ON OR BEFORE THE TENTH DAY AFTER PUBLICATION OF THE TAX RATES CHARGED. UPON CERTIFICATION OF THE OBJECTING PETITION BY THE COUNTY AUDITOR, THE STATE BOARD OF TAX COMMISSIONERS WILL FIX A DATE FOR A HEARING IN THIS COUNTY.
