AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REVISED COUNCIL DISTRICTS BEFORE THE BOONE COUNTY CLERK
AS REQUIRED BY INDIANA LAW

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon as a Third Class City is required by law to examine and, if necessary, revise its five (5) council districts in accordance with the latest census data; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon has determined that new councilmatic districts should be drawn in order to comply with current law; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have such revised mapping as necessary to the Boone County Clerk prior to November 8, 2002; and

WHEREAS, it may be necessary to cross certain pre-existing precinct boundary lines in order to equalize, as much as possible, the five (5) councilmatic districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, as follows:

Section 1. The councilmatic district maps for the City of Lebanon are hereby revised in accordance with the descriptions attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. A copy of this Ordinance shall be delivered to the Boone County Clerk for use of the Boone County Election Board and other election officials in order to incorporate the new boundaries in the 2003 municipal elections.

Section 3. New City precinct boundaries shall be drawn based upon the revised council districts as set forth herein.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after passage and publication as required by law.

District 1

Beginning at the intersection of Fordice Road and John Bart Road; thence north to the extension of Millerwood Drive; thence west to and along Millerwood Drive to Grant Street; thence south to Fordice Street; thence west to North East Street; thence south to Green Street; thence east to Spencer Avenue; thence southeast to the intersection of State Road 32 and the abandoned railroad right of way; thence north; thence east; thence north to Oak Hill Cemetery boundaries; thence west and then north around Oak Hill Cemetery; thence east along Washington Street to the existing City limits of the City of Lebanon; thence and thereafter north on John Bart Road and those areas annexed into the City of Lebanon; thence ending at the place of beginning.

District 2

From Hall Baker Road northwest along the right of way of Interstate 65 to State Road 32 East; thence north on Sam Ralston Road; thence east on Main Street and north on Patterson Street, southeast from there on the railroad right of way to Main Street; thence east to South East Street; thence south to Green Street; thence to east to Indianapolis Avenue; thence southeast to the point of beginning.

District 3

Commencing at the intersection of Lafayette Avenue and Main Street; thence west to the abandoned railroad right of way; thence northwest along the abandoned railroad right of way to Sam Ralston Road; thence north on Sam Ralston Road to Riley Road; thence northeast to Lafayette Avenue; thence southeast to Campbell Street; thence northeast to Camp Street; thence east to the intersection of Ulen Drive; thence northeast along Ulen Drive to East Street; thence south on East Street to Essex Drive; thence Essex Drive east to Grant Street; thence Grant Street south to Fordice Street; thence Fordice Street west to North East Street; thence North East Street south to West Washington Street; thence west on Washington Street to Lafayette Avenue; thence southeast on Lafayette Avenue to Main Street and the point of beginning.

District 4

From and along the right of way of Interstate 65 northwest from the junction of Interstate 65 and State Road 39 to State Road 32; thence east on State Road 32 to Sam Ralston Road; thence north to Main Street and east to North Patterson Street; continuing north to abandoned railroad right of way; thence northwest to Sam Ralston Road and from there, north to Riley Road; thence northeast to Lafayette Avenue; thence southeast to West Camp Street; from there east to North Lebanon Street; thence on North Lebanon Street north to the Small Reynolds Ditch; thence west to the railroad right of way; thence north to the City boundary; thence east to Witt Road; thence north to Persuasion Drive following a line north; thence west to intersect the right of way of Interstate 65 and southeast to the abandoned railroad right of way; thence east and south, encompassing the Lebanon Business Park; back to the point of beginning.

District 5

From the intersection of Anderson Lane and State Road 39 in a northerly direction to roughly County Road 300 North and east along 300 North encompassing only those annexed areas and continuing east; thence south encompassing the Chadwick Village Subdivision; thence south following existing City limits of the City of Lebanon; thence east to John Bart Road and continue south to the approximate location of Millerwood Drive extended east; thence west to Grant Street; thence south to Essex Drive; thence north to intersect Ulen Drive; thence southwest to Camp Street; thence west to North Lebanon Street; thence north to the Small Reynolds Ditch; thence west to the railroad right of way; thence north on the railroad right of way to the northernmost boundary of the City; thence east and then north to County Road 250 North; thence east to the point of beginning.
