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AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEBANON,
INDIANA AND PAUL JAMES HILL

THIS AGREEMENT MADE and entered into this 1st day of July, 1959,
by and between the City of Lebanon, Indiana, hereinafter called the City and Paul
James Hill, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, George Robert Daupert has been drafted into the United
States Armed Forces, and

WHEREAS, George Robert Daupert was, at the time of entering such
service, a member of the Lebanon City Fire Department and has been given a leave
of absence from said Department for the period of such service, which will be about
two years, and

WHEREAS, this leaves a temporary vacancy on said Department and
leaves said Department undermanned and public Health and Safety requires that said
Department be kept at full strength, and

WHEREAS, Paul James Hill is desirous of being appointed to said
Department,

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between the City, acting
by and through its Board of Public Works and Safety and Paul James Hill upon the
following terms and conditions:

1. The City hereby agrees to appoint Paul James Hill to the temp-
orary vacancy in the Fire Department of said City created by the leave of absence of
George Robert Daupert during the period of his service in the United States Armed
Forces, said appointment to be of a temporary nature and for the period of such
leave of absence only.

2. The City further agrees that said Paul James Hill shall be
appointed to the first permanent opening on said department regardless of whether
said opening occurs during or after the period of the temporary appointment herein
made.

3. Paul James Hill, hereby agrees that, by accepting the
appointment herein made, to accept and be bound by the conditions contained in No. 1
and No. 2 above and further agrees that said appointment to such Department hereby
made is of a temporary nature only and will expire upon the return of George
Robert Daupert to said Department.

ORDINANCE NO. 73 - BUDGET, 1960

An Ordinance appropriating moneys for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
several departments of the City Government of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, for the
fiscal year beginning January 1, 1960 and ending December 31, 1960, including out-
standing claims and obligations and fixing the time when the same shall take effect.

SECTION I: Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana,
that for the expenses of the City Government and its Institutions for the fiscal year
ending December 31, 1960 the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and
ordered set apart out of the fund herein named and for the purpose as herein specified,
subject to the laws governing the same. Such sums herein appropriated shall be held
to include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year unless otherwise
expressly stipulated and provided by law.

SECTION II: That for the said fiscal year there is hereby appropriated out of the
GENERAL FUND of said City, the following:
