ORDINANCE NO. 74, 1959 - ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1960.

*Filed, Lebanon, Indiana*

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

SECTION 1: That the salaries of the following employees of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, beginning January 1, 1960 be as follows:

A. Street Department	
Salary of Commissioners (Maximum) - - - - -	\$ 80.00 weekly
Salary of Laborers (Maximum) - - - - -	65.50 weekly
B. Garbage Dept.	
Salary of Driver (Maximum) - - - - -	65.50 weekly
Salary of Assistants (Maximum) - - - - -	65.50 weekly
Salary of Bulldozer Operator (Maximum) - - - - -	50.00 weekly
