## RESOLUTION NO. 05-03

### Resolution Directing the Revision of the Water Pollution Control Program Addressing Storm Water Discharges

WHEREAS, Congress has authorized the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to formulate regulations in furtherance of the 1972 Amendments to the Clean Water Act; and

WHEREAS, the EPA has expanded the existing National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) storm water program to address storm water discharges from small municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4s); and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) has statutory authority for regulation and rule-making in connection with the control of storm water discharge; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon by and through its Storm Water Management Board (SWMB) should be charged with the applicable revisions of the Lebanon City Code in order to regulate storm water quality management pursuant to the federal and state mandates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon that:

1. The Lebanon Storm Water Management Board is authorized and directed to revise and recommend to the Common Council of the City of Lebanon necessary amendments to the existing storm water ordinances within the city in order to comply with federal and state regulations which govern the following:

1. Discharge of prohibited non-storm water flows into the city's storm drain system;

2. Storm water drainage improvements related to the development of lands located within the jurisdictional limits of the City of Lebanon;

3. Drainage control systems installed during new construction and grading of lots and other parcels of land within the City of Lebanon;


4. Erosion and sediment control systems installed during new construction and grading of lots and other parcels of land;

5. The design, construction and maintenance of storm water drainage facilities and systems throughout the City of Lebanon;

6. The design, construction and maintenance of storm water quality facilities and systems.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that after preparing said revisions and recommendations as aforesaid, the Storm Water Management Board shall present to the Common Council for passage a comprehensive ordinance in a form for adoption and subsequent implementation.


