

RESOLUTION NO. 07-09

**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING PROJECTS TO BE  
FINANCED THROUGH REVENUES FROM THE MUNICIPAL  
FOOD AND BEVERAGE TAX**

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 05-14 established a municipal food and beverage tax fund into which the City Clerk/Treasurer deposits all tax revenues from the City's food and beverage tax;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of Ordinance No. 05-14, revenues from the food and beverage tax are treated as additional revenue for the purposes of addressing budget issues for the budget year during which the revenues are distributed;

WHEREAS, the Common Council deems it necessary to designate certain projects pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance which are to be financed through revenues from the municipal food and beverage tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon as follows:


1. Tax revenues are available from the municipal food and beverage tax for completion of special capital projects to beautify and enhance the Lebanon City Parks;


2. That it is in the best interest of the public welfare that these projects be completed and funded through the revenues from the municipal food and beverage tax for the reason that said improvements are not otherwise budgeted nor are other funds available in order to complete these projects;


3. The City Clerk/Treasurer is authorized to pay from the revenues of the municipal food and beverage tax the cost of special projects to enhance and beautify the Parks and more particularly identified by Exhibit A which documents and


designates the special projects to be completed during 2007.

SO RESOLVED this 23 day of July, 2007.






