RESOLUTION NO. 2014-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, APPROVING ISSUANCE OF BONDS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON STORM WATER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Department of Water Management of the City Lebanon, Indiana (the "City") on September 8, 2014, adopted a resolution (the "Bond Resolution") authorizing the issuance of bonds of the Storm Water District of the City (the "District"), in one or more series, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$2,000,000 (the "Bonds"), to fund the construction of certain storm water improvements as further described in Exhibit A hereto (the "Projects"); and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, as the fiscal body of the City, now desires to approve the issuance of the Bonds as required under Indiana Code 6-1.1-17-20.5 and Indiana Code 8-1.5-5-23(a);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA that:

Section 1. The Common Council hereby approves of the issuance of the Bonds of the District, in one or more series, to finance the Projects in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$2,000,000, pursuant to Indiana Code 6-1.1-17-20.5 and Indiana Code 8-1.5-5-23(a).

Section 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor as required by law.
