ORDINANCE NO. 32 - AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN REAL ESTATE BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein that:

SECTION 1: The Board of Public Works of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, is hereby authorized to purchase, for the consideration of \$20,500.00, and to accept a deed of conveyance to the City of Lebanon, Indiana from Harold Head and Pauline Head husband and wife the following described real estate in Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana to-wit:

Lot Number Three (3) in Block Twenty Two (22) in Rose, Harris, and Longley's Addition to Lebanon, Indiana, except commencing at the northwest corner of said Lot Three (3) and run south one (1) foot, thence east 122.75 feet to the east line of said lot, thence north one (1) foot to the northeast corner of said lot, thence west 122.75 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2: All acts of the said Board of Public Works preliminary to the purchase thereof taken, in connection with said purchase, and the payment of said consideration, are hereby approved and confirmed.

ORDINANCE NO. 33 - AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL COUNSEL TO ASSIST THE PRESENT AND ACTING CITY ATTORNEY, WENDELL B. IDTINGS, IN THE DEFENSE OF A CERTAIN LITIGATION IN WHICH CITY OF LEBANON IS THE DEFENDANT AND KEITH COX, ET AL ARE THE PLAINTIFF, AN ACTION REMONSTRATING AGAINST THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein, that:

SECTION 1. The firm of Scifres and Hollingsworth, attorneys, be retained to assist the present and acting City Attorney, Wendell B. Iddings, in a legal action in which the City of Lebanon, Indiana, is the defendant and Keith Cox et al are the plaintiffs.
