

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into between the City of Lebanon, by its Mayor and the Town of Ulen, by the president of its Board of Trustees this _____ day of _____, 1956 upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Town of Ulen is hereby authorized to dispose of its refuse, trash and garbage at the dump site leased by the City of Lebanon on the S. A. O'Bryan Farm on Road 32 East of said City; provided, however, that only Ira Scott or some person approved by the City of Lebanon and S. A. O'Bryan shall be permitted to haul from said town of Ulen; provided further that this authorization shall be confined to the present town limits of said town of Ulen.
2. That in consideration for said authorization to dispose of its refuse, trash and garbage at said dump site, said Town of Ulen hereby agrees to pay the City of Lebanon the sum of \$120.00 per year.
3. This agreement shall be for the term of one (1) year from August 1, 1956.
