B. The annual salary of the Parking Meter Attendant, to be paid from Parking Meter Funds, shall be \$3840.00.

SECTION 5:

A. The annual salary of the Clerical Assistant to the Clerk-Treasurer shall be \$2200.00

SECTION 6: Recreation Dept.:

A. Salary of Janitor----- \$ 19.00 weekly
