

e. All parking area must be approved by the Planning Commission.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its Approval by the Planning Commission, passage by the Common Council, Approval by the Mayor and Publication according to law.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT MADE AND ENTERED INTO by and between the STATE OF INDIANA, through the State Highway Department of Indiana, and the City of Lebanon, through its duly authorized and undersigned officials hereinafter referred to as the "City" witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the City has requested that flasher equipment be installed for the purpose of regulating traffic at the intersection of SR 39 (;South Lebanon Street) and Noble Street within said City, and

WHEREAS, the State Highway Department deems the regulation of traffic by means of glasher devices, as hereinafter designated, to be beneficial to traffic at said location to the extent of the cost of the materials and equipment.

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED BY AND BETWEEN the State, through said Department, and said City, that such traffic facilities shall be installed under terms and conditions as follows:

(1) The City, with its own forces, in consideration of the benefits to traffic using said intersection shall perform all work of installation of such facilities and the State, through said Department, hereby grants said City permission to enter upon said location for the performance of such work.

(2) That the work of installation to be performed by the City shall be performed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department, and said work shall be performed under the supervision of and to the satisfaction of the Department.

(3) The major electrical flasher equipment and materials required in said flasher installation shall be furnished and paid for by the State Highway Department.

(4) On and after the completion of the work of installation, the flasher devices so installed shall be the property of, and subject to the control of the State, through said Department, under rules and regulations of the Department and laws of the State now in force or hereinafter enacted, and the maintenance of such equipment and flasher facilities shall be at the expense of the State, through said Department.

(5) The electric energy required to operate the flasher facilities shall be furnished or paid for by the City.

(6) The City shall begin installing the flasher equipment not later than sixty (60) days after receiving the plans and specifications from the Department for said flasher installation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the State of Indiana, through said Department, and the City, through its undersigned officials, have hereunto affixed their signatures this 21st day of November, 1956.
