

authorized to suspend his permit and/or institute court action, or in lieu thereof to degrade his product and permit its sale during a temporary period not exceeding thirty (30) days or in emergencies such longer period as he may deem necessary.

SECTION 6. Such sanitary police and inspectors as may be necessary for the enforcement of this ordinance shall be employed. They shall be the authorized representatives of the health officer having jurisdiction to perform such duties of inspection and reports as may be necessary for the full enforcement of this ordinance.

Such sanitary police and inspectors shall be persons qualified and approved by the Indiana State Board of Health for the performance of said duties and shall be paid such sum as may be agreed upon by the Mayor and the health officer having jurisdiction out of such funds as may hereafter be appropriated therefore by the Common Council.

SECTION 7. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred (100.00) dollars or imprisonment in the county jail for not more than thirty (30) days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court. Each and every violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 8. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.

SECTION 9. If any section, subdivision or clause of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
