DECLARATORY RESOLUTION TO VACATE
PART OF A STREET

*Filed - Vacation - Part of
Ryan Street*

B E IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Lebanon, Indiana that:

Section 1. It is deemed necessary, in the interests of Public Health and safety, to vacate a portion of Ryan Street in the City of Lebanon, Indiana, which portion of said street is described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the west curb line of Ryan Street with the north right-of-way line of the New York Central Railroad and run thence south 100 feet more or less to the intersection of said west curb line of Ryan Street with the south right-of-way line of said railroad; run thence southeast with said south right-of-way line to its intersection with the east curb line of Ryan Street; run thence north 100 feet more or less to the intersection of said east curb line of Ryan Street with the north right-of-way of said railroad; run thence northwest with said north right-of-way line to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The property which will be injuriously or beneficially affected by said vacation is that portion of the New York Central Railroad which crosses Ryan Street.

Section 3. After approval by the Common Council, a copy of this resolution be published and a hearing be held according to law on the 13th day of May, 1957 at 2 o'clock, P.M. for objections and remonstrances to be presented to the vacation above set out.

DECLARATORY RESOLUTION TO VACATE ALLEY

Filed - Vacation of alley

B E IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Lebanon, Indiana that:

Section 1. It is desired and deemed necessary to vacate the alley between Lots No. 30 and 31 in Trips Addition to the City of Lebanon, Indiana, which alley has its beginning at the south line of Trips Avenue and run thence south between said lots to the North line of Prairie Creek Avenue all as shown by a duly recorded plat on record in the Recorder's Office, Court House, Boone County, Indiana.

Section 2. The property which will be injuriously or beneficially affected by said vacation are said Lots No. 30 and 31 as above described.

Section 3. That, after approval by the Common Council, a copy of this resolution be published and a hearing be held according to law on the 13th day of May, 1957 at 1:30 o'clock, P M for objections and remonstrances to be presented to the vacation above set out.
