ORDINANCE NO. 47 - AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, " AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE USE OF METERS AND FIXING RATES FOR THE USE OF WATER BY METER". PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL ON THE 14th day of November, 1910 as Ordinance No. 168.

Whereas, the Public Service Commission has duly entered its Order dated and approved June 28, 1957, after a hearing held June 11, 1957, by said Commission, in the matter of the application of the City of Lebanon for approval of a new schedule of water rates and charges, and by which order the Public Service Commission has fixed the rates and charges to be made by the City of Lebanon for the use of, and services rendered by, its waterworks system, all according to the provisions hereinafter set forth now,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

SECTION 1: That the title of an Ordinance regarding the use of meters and fixing rates for the use of water by meter passed by the Common Council on the 14th day of November, 1910 as Ordinance No. 168 be amended to read as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF, AND SERVICE RENDERED BY THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA.
