

Section 5. The Board of Public Works and Safety is hereby authorized to prohibit dumping of wastes into the City sewerage system which, in its discretion, are deemed harmful to the operation of the sewage works of said City, or to require methods affecting pre-treatment of said wastes to reduce the characteristics of the waste satisfactory to the Board of Public Works and Safety.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.

RESOLUTION OF  
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY  
CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

*Filed - Sewage Project*

WHEREAS, this Board has had under consideration the making of improvements, extensions and additions to the sewage works of the City of Lebanon consisting of the construction of sanitary trunk lines, including 770 feet of 24-inch sewer, 10,900 feet of 18-inch sewer, 16,010 feet of 15-inch sewer, 5230 feet of 12-inch sewer, 1400 feet of 10-inch sewer, and 100 feet of 8-inch sewer, including 95 manholes, said work being designated as Contract A; and the construction of a sewage treatment plant consisting of Operations Building, Grit Collector, Primary Clarifier, trickling filters, secondary clarifiers, digestion tanks, sludge control house, chlorine contact basin, utility garage and fencing, said work being designated as Contract B, and in furtherance thereof has heretofore received bids on said improvements, extensions and additions, and on the basis of the lowest and best bids received and estimates made by Paul J. Kleiser & Associates, consulting engineers of Terre Haute, Indiana, heretofore employed by the City, the total cost of said improvements, extensions, and additions including contingencies, engineering, legal and other expenses is estimated to be \$1,250,000.00, itemized as follows:

WHEREAS, in order to finance said improvements, extensions and additions it will be necessary to issue revenue bonds in the amount of \$1,250,000.00 payable out of the revenues of the sewage works of the City; and

WHEREAS, counsel employed by the City, Scifres & Hollingsworth, has prepared for consideration by this Board and the Common Council a suggested form for the bond ordinance based upon data furnished by the consulting engineers of the City, which ordinance has been duly considered by this Board and found satisfactory; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA:

1. That this Board request the Common Council of the City of Lebanon to authorize the issuance of sewage works revenue bonds in the amount of \$1,250,000.00 on the terms and conditions set out in the form of bond ordinance presented at this meeting.

2. That the Secretary of the Board be and he is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Clerk-Treasurer for presentation to the Common Council
