Subject: City of Lebanon Sewer Project

Charles Suppiger has handed me your pencil drawing of a proposed sewer line to be laid beneath the Lebanon plant property, also legal form for "Easement For Sanitary Sewer" by which this company would grant an easement for this purpose. In the easement form I note that the center line of the easement is incorporated by reference to plans and specifications on file in the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Lebanon.

Certain precautions must be observed.

1. We should definitely locate the center line of the easement on the survey of our plant property in order to be absolutely certain that the sewer easement would not encroach upon any of our existing structure. For this purpose you will need, and I enclose from the Engineering Department files, a legal description of the plant site which is attached to survey dated March, 1956, prepared by Donald M. Woods, also a large detailed plat prepared in our Engineering Department by our own draftsmen.

2. We will not be able to use the easement form since a special easement will have to be prepared to suit our reservations. We should reserve or specify,

a. Reserve the right to erect buildings, construct driveways, lay steam and power lines over, across and beneath said easement and,

b. Specify that the City is to dig the trench, lay the sewer pipes and perform the back fill on the feeder line from our sewage house over to the proposed sewer manhole.
