RESOLUTION NO. 18 - RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A BOARD OF AVIATION COMMISSIONERS.

WHEREAS, the Common Council feels that a Board of Aviation Commissioners should be appointed and authorized to investigate the need for this facility

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that

SECTION I: There is hereby established a Board of Aviation Commissioners for said City, and the Mayor is hereby instructed to appoint said board in accordance with the laws of Indiana.

SECTION II: Said Board is hereby directed to investigate the need herein above set out, and report its findings back to this Council.

Petition No. 21 - Street Light, Entrance to Delpark and Shumate.

I am writing this letter on behalf of Shumate, Inc. and Delpark Corporation to ask for the installation of a street light at the entrance to our plants from State Road 32.

Most of our people come to work and return to their homes before and after dark. Our night shift people come and go at all hours of the night. This creates a considerable traffic hazard, particularly if the car turning in has to stop and wait for traffic in the other lane. We have had a number of very narrow escapes because it seems that drivers following the car which is turning in fail to realize that the car in front has stopped.

Whatever the reason, we feel that a street light would improve the situation materially and would improve a very hazardous situation. If we should take any other steps toward presenting this matter to the Council, please let me know what should be done. We will greatly appreciate any help you can give us in this matter.
