ORDINANCE NO. 54 - AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC CARRIERS, REQUIRING A LICENSE THEREFOR, MAKING PROVISION FOR LIABILITY INSURANCE, PROVIDING FOR DRIVER'S LICENSE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION, THEREOF" PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL ON THE 9th DAY OF DECEMBER, 1946.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Lebanon, Indiana;

SECTION 1: That Section 2 of the above entitled Ordinance be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2: FEES FOR LICENSING PUBLIC CARRIERS.

The following annual license fees shall be paid by the owner:

For the first taxicab or automobile for hire, the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars; for each additional taxicab or automobile for hire, Five (\$5.00) Dollars each.

Such license fees shall entitle the owner to a taxi stand for each cab not exceeding (2) in front of his place of business; provided however that upon the payment of the sum of Five Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$5.20) per month for one or more additional taxicab or automobile said owner with the consent of the Common Council may be entitled to one space at the curb for each one or more additional taxicab or automobile paid for; provided that said additional spaces shall be designated by the Common Council.

Such license fee shall be in lieu of, and not in addition to any fees heretofore established, and except as above provided no fees or other charge shall be collected by the city. Provided, however, that each additional taxicab or automobile for which no curb space has been paid shall pay the parking meter fees established by ordinance.

Licenses so issued under this ordinance shall extend for a period of one (1) year, beginning the first of January each year, and no license shall be issued to extend beyond December 31st in year issued. In the case of licenses issued on or after October 1st in each year hereafter one-half of the above fees shall be paid.

SECTION 2: That section 3 of the above entitled Ordinance be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3: INSURANCE REQUIRED

Before any permit or license for public carrier shall be issued, the owner shall file with the City Council a certificate of insurance showing that an insurance policy has been issued to said owner by reputable insurance company licensed to do business in the State of Indiana and approved by the City Council, providing insurance coverage for each and every carrier owned, operated or leased by the applicant. Said policy shall provide no less insu
