

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this twenty-fifth (25th) day of August, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight (1958), by and between CENTRAL GREYHOUND LINES (Division of the Greyhound Corporation), party of the first part, and the CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, party of the second part.

Party of the second part agrees to furnish party of the first part regular storage in their garage at 211 South Lebanon Street, Lebanon, Indiana, for one (1) coach at the rate of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per month.

Party of the second part further agrees to permit said coach to be so stored that it will be available for use in the event of emergency. The coach will be normally stored Monday through Friday between the hours of 6:00 PM and 7:00 AM, and on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays it will be stored all day.

Party of the second part further agrees to heat the garage facilities so as to preclude the possibility of the bus equipment becoming damaged as a result of freezing weather.

THIS AGREEMENT is to be in effect on the first (1st) day of September, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight (1958), and to run from month to month unless cancelled by either party by fifteen (15) days' written notice.

ORDINANCE NO. 61, 1958 - ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1959

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

SECTION 1: That the salaries of the following employees of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, beginning January 1, 1959 be as follows:

SECTION 2: That the salaries of the following officers to be paid from funds of the municipal utilities shall be as follows:

SECTION 3: The annual salaries of the members of the Utility Service Board shall be \$500.00 each.

SECTION 4:

A. The annual salary for Parking Meter Accounting to be paid from Parking Meter Funds to City Clerk-Treasurer, shall be \$1600.00.

B. The annual salary of the Parking Meter Attendant, to be paid from Parking Meter Funds, shall be \$3840.00.

SECTION 5:

A. The annual salary of the Clerical Assistant to the Clerk-Treasurer shall be \$2200.00.

SECTION 6: Recreation Dept.

A. Salary of Janitor-----	\$	19.00 weekly

SECTION 7:

A. The salary for clerical help in the Police Department, to be paid from Parking Meter Funds, shall be \$1.00 hourly.
