ORDINANCE NO. 63 - AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "An Ordinance regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, demolition, conversion, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area, maintenance, electricity, plumbing, heating, ventilation, and air conditioning of all public and private buildings or structures in the City of Lebanon, Indiana: The creation of a building inspector: Provisions for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor." PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL ON THE 11th day of August, 1952 as Ordinance No. 8

Be It ~~Ordained~~ by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

SECTION 1: That Section 2 of said above entitled ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. There is hereby established in the City of Lebanon, Indiana, the office of Building Inspector; provided that the holder of said office shall be an employee of the Lebanon Utilities.

SECTION 2: That Section 3 of said above entitled ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. The Building Inspector shall be appointed by the Mayor upon recommendation of the superintendent of the Lebanon Utilities and said appointment shall be subject to the approval of the Common Council: his appointment shall continue during good behavior and service and he shall not be removed from office except for cause after full opportunity has been given him to be heard on specific charges. Provided, that said Inspector shall be paid a sum in addition to his regular salary as an employee of the Lebanon Utilities for his time and expenses. Said sum shall be paid out of the Inspection Fund hereinafter established and the amount thereof shall be determined by the Lebanon Utility Service Board upon recommendation of the Utility Superintendent.

SECTION 3: That the above entitled ordinance shall be amended further by the insertion of a section between Section 9 and Section 10 thereof which shall be numbered Section 9A: And shall read as follows:

Section 9A. All sums collected under Section nine hereof shall be part of the funds of the Lebanon Utilities and shall be deposited in a fund called the Inspection Fund; provided, however, that the Common Council may, by ordinance, transfer any surplus remaining in said fund at the end of any calendar year to any other funds of the Lebanon Utilities or to the General Fund of the Civil City.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and due publication according to law.
