A part of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 25, Township 19 North, Range 1 West, and being situated in Lebanon, Indiana, and being more particularly described as follows, to wit:

From the Northwest corner of the aforesaid tract, proceed thence Easterly with the North line of the quarter-quarter section for a distance of 289.5 feet to the point of beginning. From said point of beginning continue thence Easterly with the aforesaid line for a distance of 249 feet; thence proceed South 0 degrees East for a distance of 25.0 feet; thence proceed North 90 degrees West for a distance of 249 feet; thence proceed North 0 degrees East for a distance of 25.0 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.143 acres more or less.
