

For field time necessary to make the survey of the corporation line \$12.50 per hour for a three-man field crew, furnishing all the necessary equipment, etc., and \$5.00 per hour for office time, calculation, etc., the billing to be on an hourly basis with a maximum of \$2500.00, the maximum to be for survey time only. The time necessary for supervision of installation of permanent monuments shall be billed at \$7.50 per hour for one man and shall be in addition to the survey and drafting time aforesated. The maximum for this phase shall be entirely dependent upon the City of Lebanon's speed in setting the monuments.

For preparing the new City map set forth, the City of Lebanon shall pay at the rate of \$5.00 per hour for a draftsman's time with an estimated maximum of \$1000.00. Should the time involved be greater than ten percent more than \$1000.00, the City of Lebanon agrees to pay the actual cost of the draftsman to finish the map, extra time not to exceed twenty-five percent of the estimated cost.

The P. E. Middleton Co., Inc., will furnish the City of Lebanon a tracing on cloth suitable for reproduction of the city map, but any reproductions of the map requested by the City shall be paid for at cost plus ten percent.

The payment for each phase of the work shall be made upon completion of that phase and within thirty days from the date of the submission of a bill to the City of Lebanon.

The City of Lebanon and the P. E. Middleton Co., Inc., hereby agree to the performance of the covenants herein contained. In witness thereof, they have signed this agreement in triplicate this 13th day of April, 1959.

RESOLUTION NO. 25

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A REGULAR
SCHEDULE FOR THE SWEEPING OF THE STREETS

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Indiana is the woner of mechanical street sweeping equipment; And
WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that the City secure the greatest and most efficient use possible from this equipment.
NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that:
SECTION 1: The Mayor and Street Commissioner establish a regular schedule for the sw eeping of the Streets of said City.
SECTION 2: The schedule so established be made public so that the citizens of said City may know when it will be necessary to leave the curbs free so that said sweeping equipment may do the most efficient job of cleaning the streets.
SECTION 3: Further, the Street Commissioner shall post such Streets to be cleaned on the day before they are scheduled to be cleaned.
SECTION 4: All parking be prohibited on said Street so posted during the period of cleaning.
SECTION 5: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
