CONTRACT CONSTRUCTION OF STREET IMPROVEMENTS

This agreement entered into this 9th day of March, 1959, by and between the City of Lebanon, by and through its Board of Works, hereinafter called "City" and Leonard V. Cramer, hereinafter called "Contractor", is as follows:

The Contractor agrees to furnish all labor and materials necessary for the construction of sidewalks, curbs, gutters and storm sewers along both sides of Garfield Street between Camp Street and West Chicago Street and along the South Side of Essex Street between North Lebanon Street and Garfield Street, all according to the plans and specifications adopted by the Board of Works November 11, 1958 by Sidewalk Improvement Resolution No. 1, 1958, and according to the bid and for the price named in said bid as submitted by the contractor at the public letting had February 23, 1959. Contractor agrees to furnish performance bond as required.

The Contractor agrees to commence work within 30 days from this date and to complete the project not later than September 1, 1959.
