Rephone today.

This is to ask for your, and the City Council's, consideration of a street light installation to go in at the intersection of state road 32 and packing house county road. I believe this marks the western city limits line at this point.

My three reasons for bring/this to your attention are:

1. At night ones car lights do not help much to see the road ahead as a driver turns off of state road 32 onto the packing house road because the lights from the car shine over the road leaving the driver to turn into that sharp down grade approach into the county road. With the new high grade caused by the new elevated state road 32 at this point there is a serious safety problem at this corner without proper lighting.
2. Mark the western edge of Lebanon City Limits.
3. Recommended by the Police Department to help reduce break-ins in the Siess-Duff Company building where three break-ins have ocured since the first of this year. In all cases entrance has been made from the west side of the building.
