

ORDINANCE NO. 67 - AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF CITY JUDGE FOR THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION AND TERM OF A CITY JUDGE, AND THE SALARY AND EXPENSES THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana: *Repealed 2-27-63*

SECTION 1. That there is hereby created the office of City Judge for the City of Lebanon, Indiana, effective January 1, 1960. Provided however that the holder of said office shall be a qualified attorney admitted to the practise of Law.

SECTION 2: That said City Judge shall establish a minimum of one regularly scheduled session of Court each week to be continued until all pending cases are disposed of. *Ordinance No. 9*

SECTION 3: That the first incumbent to fill the office hereby created shall be elected at the next city election to be held in 1959, and each year thereafter when city elections are held, in accordance with the provisions of law now or hereafter in effect, for a term as provided by law, and said Judge shall exercise the powers and duties of such office as provided for under Chapter 129 of the Acts of the Indiana General Assembly of 1905, and as said law has been amended and supplemented.

SECTION 4: That it shall be the duty of the proper officers of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, to include in the annual budget of said City each and every year, for the following year, beginning with the budget prepared in 1959 for the year 1960, the amount of salary fixed by ordinance for City Judge, as by law now provided, and necessary expenses of the office.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 68, 1959 - AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF ALL ELECTED OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, PAYABLE FROM THE GENERAL FUND, EFFECTIVE AT THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TERMS OF SUCH OFFICERS NEXT SUCCEEDING THE GENERAL ELECTION OF 1959, AS PROVIDED FOR BY CHAPTER 107 OF THE ACTS OF 1959.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Lebanon, Indiana:

SECTION 1. That the annual salaries of the Mayor, the Clerk-Treasurer, City Judge, and each member of the Common Council, effective at the commencement of the terms of said officers next succeeding the general election of 1959, payable from the General Fund of said City, shall be in the following amounts:

Mayor - - - - -	\$ 4000.00
Clerk-Treasurer - - - - -	6000.00
City Judge - - - - -	1500.00
Members of Common Council (each) - - - - -	240.00

SECTION 2. The Clerk-Treasurer is ordered and directed to publish this ordinance twice in a newspaper of general circulation in the English language in this City, the first of which publications shall be at least 30 days prior to the date of the passage of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force from and after its passage, and shall be effective as to the salaries provided herein on and after January 1, 1960.

ORDINANCE NO. 69 - AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE DEPARTMENTS NAMED FOR THE YEAR 1959, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CLERK-TREASURER OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA.

WHEREAS: Certain extraordinary conditions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget for the various functions of City Government, to meet such extraordinary emergencies:
