

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into between the City of Lebanon, by its Mayor and the Town of Ulen, by the president of its Board of Trustees this 12th day of October, 1959 upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Town of Ulen is hereby authorized to dispose of its refuse, trash and garbage at the dump site on the City's Farm on Road 52 North of said City; provided, however, that only Ira Scott or some person approved by the City of Lebanon shall be permitted to haul from said Town of Ulen; provided further that this authorization shall be confined to the present town limits of said Town of Ulen.

2. That in consideration for said authorization to dispose of its refuse, trash and garbage at said dump site, said Town of Ulen hereby agrees to pay the City of Lebanon the sum of \$120.00 per year.

3. This agreement shall be for the term of two (2) years from August 1, 1959.

ORDINANCE NO. 75 -AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENTS NAMED FOR THE YEAR 1959, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CLERK-TREASURER OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

Filed Appropriations Special

WHEREAS: Certain extraordinary conditions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget for the various functions of City Government, to meet such extraordinary emergencies:

SECTION 1. Be It Ordained By The Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that for the expense of City Government the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and set apart out of the General Fund, Park Fund and Fire Fighting Equipment Fund for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same, such sums herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year, unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided by law.

Section 2. That for said fiscal period there is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund, the following specified amounts to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are hereby declared to exist:

GENERAL FUND:

POLICE DEPARTMENT

7-J Police Dept Repairs to Radio Equipment----\$ 50.00

SECTION 3. That for said fiscal period there is hereby appropriated out of the Park Fund, the following specified amount to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are hereby declared to exist:

PARK FUND:

2-22 Park Dept Lights, Water, Telephone - - - - - \$100.00

SECTION 4. That for said fiscal period there is hereby appropriated out of the Fire Fighting Equipment Fund, the following specified amount to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are hereby declared to exist:

FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT FUND:

28- Fire Fighting Equipment; Maintenance - - - - - #725.00
