

All promotions must be approved by the Board of Public Works of the City of Lebanon.

For the purposes of this amendment, all policemen and firemen employed by the City of Lebanon at date of passage of this amendment, shall be declared to be of First Class rank in their respective departments.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor.

The following residents of East North Street are asking for a street light on the alley between 210 East North Street and 216 East North Street ~~or~~ directly across the street.

It is almost a necessity that a light be placed in this vicinity, not only because the area is dangerously dark and hazardous for pedestrians but also because of the location. This alley is used as much as a street and it goes back to a car parking lot and an old building which could encourage juvenile delinquency because it is such an unlighted section.

By checking on this part of the uptown area, city officials will soon realize that this can easily be fertile ground for teen-age disorders.

It would be easy and not too expensive to light the district because of light pole locations thus avoiding problems that might arise later.

BUFFY collections are being asked now for money to help law officials in their fight against crime, particularly juvenile offenses, and well-lighted parts of town are a big aid in keeping our streets free from crime.

In checking other street areas it is found that there are many places with lights in similar spots.
