CONTRACT FOR JOINT USE OF DUMPING GROUND

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 15th day of May, 1959, by and between the Board of Commissioners of the County of Boone, State of Indiana, hereinafter called the County, and the Board of Public Works and Safety, of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, hereinafter called the City, is as follows:

It is the desire of the County to secure the use of suitable land for dumping purposes, for the benefit of the citizens and taxpayers of Boone County, and the City is the owner of approximately 129 acres of land, located in Section 9, Township 19 north, Range 1 west in Washington Township, which lies along the east side of U.S. Road No. 52 and that said City has set aside and are using a portion of said ground for dumping purposes. It is the further desire of the parties that said dumping ground be made available to all the citizens of Boone County.

For AND in consideration of the payment of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars annually, the City hereby grants and leases to Boone County for a period of Five years from the date hereof, the right of joint use of that portion of said above described land reserved by the City for dumping purposes, to be used by the citizens of Boone County as a place to dump refuse, cans and trash at places to be designated by the attendant of said dumping grounds. It is understood that the parties hereto will permit dumping during the regular hours said dump is attended each day.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: On May 1, 1959, the State Highway Department of Indiana herewith rescinds its action taken on March 13, 1959, which minute of such action of March 13, 1959 reads as follows:

On March 13, 1959, the Commission advised the Maintenance Department to discontinue standard maintenance such as street sweeping, cleanup (city of Lebanon rental), patching, re-surfacing, snow and ice control, and traffic devices on Roads 32 and 39 within the city limits of Lebanon. The maintenance will be discontinued until further notice since the State Highway Department has no control over the signage, signalling, and parking on the streets over which these highways are routed. A study of re-routing of said highways around Lebanon is being made. A report will be made to the Commission at a later date.

WHEREAS: As of this date, May 1, 1959, the State Highway Department of Indiana by its action re-instates maintenance on State Roads 39 and 32 through the City of Lebanon as per agreement reached with the Mayor of the City of Lebanon on April 24, 1959, copy of which letter is attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked "Exhibit A";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the passage of this resolution does hereby re-instate all of such maintenance and traffic services discontinued by its action of March 13, 1959.
