

ORDINANCE NO. 81 - AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
 PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS
 FOR THE DEPARTMENTS NAMED FOR THE
 YEAR 1960, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CLERK-
 TREASURER OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

Filed Appropriations Special 73

WHEREAS: Certain extraordinary conditions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget for the various functions of City Government, to meet such extraordinary emergencies:

SECTION 1. Be It Ordained By The Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that for the expense of City Government the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and set apart out of the General Fund and Parking Meter Fund for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same, such sums herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year, unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided by law.

SECTION 2. That for said fiscal period there is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund, the following specified amounts to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are hereby declared to exist:

GENERAL FUND:

7-J	Police Dept., Repairs to Radio Equipment - - -	\$ 50.00
12-C	Street Dept., Supplies and Repairs - - - - -	1500.00

SECTION 3. That for said fiscal period there is hereby appropriated out of the Parking Meter Fund, the following specified amounts to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are hereby declared to exist:

PARKING METER FUND:

19-A	Salaries - - - - -	\$1750.00
19-H	Purchase of Equipment - - - - -	1050.00
