

SECTION 11. That said Building Inspector shall be paid out of the Inspection Fund hereinafter established, and that his salary shall be \$1200.00 per year payable monthly.

SECTION 12. A person who shall violate a provision of this ordinance or fail to comply therewith on any of the requirements thereof or who shall erect, construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, remove, demolish, convert, occupy or use a building or structure in violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punishable by fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

SECTION 13. As an additional remedy to prevent violations of this ordinance the City shall have the power to seek relief by injunction in a court of competent jurisdiction.

SECTION 14. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 15. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and due publication according to law.

ORDINANCE NO. 79

Filed - Parking ordinance

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING IN ALLEYS AND IN LAWNS BETWEEN SIDEWALKS AND CURBS"

PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL ON THE 13th DAY OF JUNE 1955 AS ORDINANCE NO. 55

Be It Ordained by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of the above entitled ordinance be amended and when amended, shall read as follows: It shall be unlawful for any person, party, firm, or corporation to park, or leave standing, any automobile, truck, trailer, tractor, or any vehicle, within any alley in the City of Lebanon, Indiana, except for purposes of loading or unloading.

SECTION 2. That Section 2 of the above entitled ordinance be amended and when amended, shall read as follows: It shall be unlawful for any person, party, firm, or corporation to park, or leave standing, any automobile, truck, trailer, tractor, or any vehicle, at, on, or within any lawn, sidewalk, or the space between the sidewalk and curb and gutter in or on any street in the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

SECTION 3. That a new section known as Section 3 be added to read as follows: The Police Department of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, is hereby granted the power to remove, push, pull or tow-in or cause to be removed, pushed, pulled or towed-in to any municipal parking lot in the City of Lebanon, Indiana, or such other place or places as the Chief of Police may select and designate from time to time, any automobile, truck, trailer, tractor or any vehicle in violation of the provisions of this ordinance; and any and all charges by reason of any such removal, pulling, pushing or towing-in of any automobile, truck, trailer, tractor or any vehicle shall be levied against the legal title holder of any such automobile, truck, trailer, tractor or any other vehicle; provided, that any such charge for any such removal of pulling, pushing or towing-in shall be in addition to the fine hereinafter stated.

SECTION 4. That a new section known as Section 4 be added to read as follows: Any person, party, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance, or fail to comply with any of the requirements hereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00), nor more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each and every separate violation hereof.
