ORDINANCE NO. 85, 1960 AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGISTRATION AND REGULATING THE USE OF BICYCLES IN THE CITY OF LEBANON AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or use a bicycle propelled wholly or in part by muscular power upon any of the streets, alleys or public highways of the City of Lebanon, without first obtaining from the Police Department a license therefor.

SECTION II. The Police Department is hereby authorized and directed to issue upon application, bicycle licenses which shall be effective from the 1st day of July, 1960, to and including the 30th day of June, 1961, and thereafter said licenses shall be issued for the fiscal year, commencing on the 1st day of July, 1961, and ending on the 30th day of June, 1962, and annually on a fiscal year basis thereafter. Said licenses when issued shall entitle the licensee to operate such bicycle for which said license has been issued upon all the streets, alleys and public highways exclusive of the sidewalks thereof in the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

SECTION III. The City of Lebanon shall provide each year license plates, and which plates shall carry a number for purposes of identification, indicating the year for which the same are issued; it shall be the duty of the Police Department to attach the license plate to each bicycle on which an application is made for a license, and that said license plate shall remain attached during the existence of such license, and that the Police Depart-
