

78 ment shall keep a record of the date of issuance of each license, to whom issued and the number thereof.

SECTION IV. It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully or maliciously remove, destroy, mutilate or alter the license plate attached to any bicycle licensed pursuant to this ordinance and during the time in which such license plate is operative.

SECTION V. The annual license fee to be paid for each bicycle shall be Twenty-five (25¢) Cents and which shall be paid in advance by the applicant. All license fees collected under this ordinance shall be paid into the General Fund of the City of Lebanon.

SECTION VI. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle on the sidewalk within one block of the public downtown square or to park or lay a bicycle on the sidewalk within said area.

SECTION VII. The Police Department is hereby authorized and directed to remove or cause to be removed any bicycle found parked or laying on the sidewalk within one block of the public downtown square to the Police Station where the owner thereof may re-claim his said bicycle upon proof of ownership and payment of a levy of Twenty-five (25¢) Cents and which levy shall be in addition to the fine hereinafter stated.

SECTION VIII. That in the interest of safety, all persons riding a bicycle on the streets, alleys and public highways within the City of Lebanon shall at all times observe the traffic laws of said City the same as operators of automobiles, and that all persons riding bicycles shall abide by the following safety code, to wit: - -

1. Obey all traffic signs and signals.
2. Never carry another person on the cross bar, handle bars or rear carrier.
3. Always ride on the right-hand side of the street, close to the curb or parked line of cars.
4. Ride single file and keep a safe distance behind the vehicle or bicycle ahead.
5. Ride in a straight line and do not weave or make sharp turns in traffic. Never dart in and out of traffic.
6. Do not attempt to pass the moving vehicle ahead at intersections. Wait until you pass the intersection.
7. Always ride at a safe speed.
8. When riding at night you are required to have a white light on the front and a red light or approved reflector on the rear.
9. Keep bicycle in good condition, with a bell or horn, good brakes and seat and handle bars properly adjusted.
10. Never "hitch" to a moving vehicle.
11. Park your bicycle in a proper place, standing upright.
12. Keep out of car tracks and ruts.
13. Never stunt or race in traffic. Keep bicycle under control.
14. Always ride with caution and courtesy.

SECTION IX. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance, or fail to comply with any of the requirements hereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-five (25¢) Cents, nor more than Five (\$5.00) Dollars for each and every separate violation hereof.

SECTION X. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION XI. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and legal publication.
