RESOLUTION NO. 32  
RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA *Filed Resolutions*

WHEREAS, there is located within the City of Lebanon a public park commonly referred to as the Southside Park, and,

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon desires to name said park so that hereafter all persons may identify and know the location of said park by the name, and,

WHEREAS, the first settler of this community came in 1832 from Oxford, Ohio, and built the first house within the then platted City of Lebanon on the southwest corner of the public square. That the first settler was Abner H. Longley and was a Universalist minister. That Abner H. Longley was a prominent and important person in this community. That he died in 1879 in Paoli, Kansas, and,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon that the public park located on the south side of the City of Lebanon be named THE ABNER H. LONGLEY PUBLIC PARK and referred to as such hereafter.

FIRE DEPARTMENT CONTRACT *Filed-Fire Department*

THIS CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT, Made and entered into in duplicate by and between the City of Lebanon, Indiana, first party, and Center Township in Boone County, Indiana, second party, is as follows, to-wit:

The said first party agrees to proceed to ~~ex~~ extinguish to the best of its ability all fires occurring in the City of Lebanon and Center Township, Boone County, Indiana, and that it will furnish a fire force sufficient to operate the fire equipment now in possession of said first party and two additional firemen on the fire force and that it will answer all calls to fires within the City of Lebanon and within the said Center Township and to the best of its ability extinguish the fires to which they are called.

The said second party in consideration of the agreements of the first party above written now agrees to furnish one fire truck which is now in the possession of said first party and pay the wages of two additional firemen to be employed by said City and further agrees that all firemen shall be under the jurisdiction of said City of Lebanon, Indiana, and shall be subject to the orders of the fire chief or assistant fire chief as the case may be in said City. Said Center Township further agrees to keep said fire truck above mentioned in proper condition and gas and oil the same at proper intervals as the case may require and that they will pay the insurance on the two extra firemen to be employed by said City of Lebanon and other incidental expenses, such as laundry and clothing allowance, and firemen's pension.

It is agreed and mutually understood by and between the parties to this contract that the City of Lebanon shall employ two additional firemen to assist in fighting and extinguishing to the best of their ability the fires occurring in said City and within said Center Township. It is further agreed and mutually understood by and between the parties that the City of Lebanon may use said truck for emergency purposes at any time within the term of this contract.

It is further agreed that this contract shall begin as of this date, to-wit: January 1, 1961 and extend to the 31st day of December, 1962. It is further agreed by and between the parties that this contract shall continue in full force and effect for additional periods of one year by automatic operation unless one party gives notice to the other party of their intention to terminate the contract at the expiration of any year, on or before November 1st.

It is further agreed between these parties that said Center Township shall pay to the City of Lebanon, Indiana, from time to time as they are billed therefor, a sufficient sum of money to pay two additional firemen together with insurance charges as above provided,
