

AGREEMENT

Filed - Garbage Landfill

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 27th day of April, 1960 by and between the City of Lebanon, Indiana hereinafter called the City and the Town of Sheridan, Indiana, hereinafter called the Town, upon the following terms and conditions, WITNESSETH:

1. The City hereby agrees, to permit the Town to have access to and use the Sanitary Landfill owned and now being operated by the City on Road No. 52 four miles north of Lebanon, Indiana, the use by the Town to be for the purpose of disposing of the garbage collected by the Town from its residents.

2. As consideration for the above and foregoing agreement on the part of the City, the Town hereby agrees to pay the sum of \$50.00 per month to the City; provided however, that should the Town have more than 15 barrels of garbage in any one week, they shall pay to the City an additional sum of 80¢ per barrel for each barrel over said 15 barrels, and an accurate count shall be kept of said barrels by the operator of said landfill. The Town further agrees to instruct its employees to dispose of its garbage at the direction of said operator.

3. It is further agreed that this agreement shall be for a term of five years (5) and shall continue in effect unless one party notifies the other of its intention to cancel the same given at least sixty (60) days prior to the time that they wish to cancel.

In Witness whereof, the parties hereto have set their respective hands and seals this 27th day of April, 1960, the City by its Board of Works and the Town by its Town Board.

ORDINANCE NO. 89 - AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION
ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL
APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENTS
NAMED FOR THE YEAR 1961, AS
RECOMMENDED BY THE CLERK-TREASURER
OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

WHEREAS: Certain extraordinary conditions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget for the various functions of City Government, to meet such extraordinary emergencies:

SECTION 1. Be It Ordained By The Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that for the expense of City Government the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and set apart out of the General Fund, Fire Fighting Equipment Fund, Gasoline Fund and Parking Meter Fund for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same, such sums herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year, unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided by law.

SECTION 2. That for said fiscal period there is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund, the following specified amounts to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are hereby declared to exist:

GENERAL FUND:

5-D	Garbage Dept Payment to Utilities, Garbage Landfill	\$ 1200.00
5-E	Garbage Dept Repairs and Maintenance, Garbage Landfill	500.00
6-A	Health Dept Salaries	20.00

SECTION 3. That for said fiscal period there is hereby appropriated out of the Fire Fighting Equipment Fund, the following specified amount to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are hereby declared to exist:
