

ORDINANCE NO. 94 - AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION
ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL
APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENTS
NAMED FOR THE YEAR 1961, AS
RECOMMENDED BY THE CLERK-TREASURER
OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

THEREAS: Certain extraordinary conditions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget for the various functions of City Government, to meet such extraordinary emergencies:

SECTION 1. Be It Ordained By The Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that for the expense of City Government the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and set apart out of the Firemen's Pension Fund for the purpose herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same, such sums herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year, unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided by law.

SECTION 2. That for said fiscal period there is hereby appropriated out of the Firemen's Pension Fund, the following specified amounts to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are hereby declared to exist:

16-2, Pensions Paid To Retired Firemen - - - - - \$ 998.25

CONTRACT *Filed Utilities*

This agreement made and entered into on the date hereinafter set out by and between the City of Lebanon and the Lebanon Utility Service Board, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon is in dire need of a tractor shovel or crawler to be used at the Sanitary Land Fill for the reason that the present equipment is worn and inadequate, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon does not have the finances at the present time with which to purchase such equipment and,

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon has received bids on this type of equipment and the bid made by Flesch-Miller, Inc. whereby they agreed to furnish an Allis-Chalmers HD-7G Diesel for the following price, to wit: that said Diesel would cost \$20,224.50 and that an allowance for the present piece of equipment owned by the City of \$7225.00 would be allowed as a trade-in, and that the net cost of said equipment would be \$12,999.50, to which the following additions are necessary, being a cab for \$500.00, bucket teeth, \$161.00, heater and defroster \$65.00 and a windshield wiper for \$25.00, making the total net cost of said equipment \$13,750.50, and,

WHEREAS, the Lebanon Utility Service Board has funds available to purchase said equipment for and on behalf of the City of Lebanon, and,

It is therefore mutually agreed that the City of Lebanon accept the bid of \$13,750.50 for said equipment, and that the Lebanon Utility Service Board will pay the Seller said sum. That the City of Lebanon agrees to pay the sum of \$750.50 to the Lebanon Utility Service Board during the year 1962 to be applied on the cost of said equipment, and further agrees to pay the sum of \$3250.00 annually for a period of four years in order to pay and reimburse the Lebanon Utility Service Board for the cost of the above described equipment.
