APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY PATROLMAN

Filed - Police Department

By the power and authority delegated to me as MAYOR OR THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, and, by his sworn oath to uphold and enforce the laws of said City and of the State of Indiana and the Government of the United States, I do hereby delegate Police Powers to OTIS W. BOYLAND. In so doing, I appoint said Otis W. Boyland to act as Temporary Police Officer of Lebanon, Indiana, to act under the direction of Police Chief Fay D. Beaman and the Board of Public and Safety of said City, only during the weeks used by regular Police Officers and Desk Men for earned vacations for 1961.

This appointment shall have the effect of granting said Officer all of the powers and duties of any other Officer, during the above mentioned tenure, but shall not give him membership in the "Pension System" participated in by regular members of the Lebanon City Police Department.
