By the power and authority delegated me as MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, and, by his sworn oath to uphold and enforce the laws of said City and of the State of Indiana and the Government of the United States, I do hereby delegate Police Powers to Wilbur R. Slagle. In so doing, I appoint said Wilbur R. Slagle to act as Temporary Police Officer of Lebanon, Indiana, to act under the direction of Police Chief Fay D. Beaman and the Board of Public Works and Safety of said City, only during the time of the incapacity of regular police officer Ross A. Pauley.

This appointment shall have the effect of granting said officer all of the powers and duties of any other officer, during the above mentioned tenure, but shall not give him membership in the "Pension System" participated in by regular members of the Lebanon City Police Department.
