CONTRACT FOR CONCESSIONS AT LEBANON MEMORIAL PARK  
FOR THE YEAR 1962

This contract made and entered into by and between the MEMORIAL PARK BOARD OF LEBANON, INDIANA, hereinafter known as the PARTY OF THE FIRST PART, and BROWN-DOLSON POST 113, THE AMERICAN LEGION, LEBANON, INDIANA, to be known as the PARTY OF THE SECOND PART;

WHEREAS: The party of the first part rents and leases to the party of the second part, for the year 1962, beginning January 1, 1962 and ending December 31, 1962, the use of said Park for refreshment stand or stands then situated in said Park, or may be used therein by party of the second part, relative to the refreshment stands and concessions for and in consideration of THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) cash in hand, receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged, and;

WHEREAS: Said party of the second part agrees to take good care of the premises and not to commit any waste or damage thereto or to permit any waste or damages to be committed to said premises by others and at all times use said premises for lawful purposes and in lawful and law-abiding manner, and;

WHEREAS: Said party of the second part agrees not to sell beer or liquor or to permit the sale of same on said premises, and;

WHEREAS: It is a condition of this lease that in the event the lessee shall break any of the conditions of this contract as set out, the party of the first part shall have the right to declare this lease forfeited and shall have the right to demand possession of all premises, and;

WHEREAS: The party of the second part agrees to surrender possession on or about December 31, 1962 and peacefully and without notice, in as good condition as it was at execution of this contract, reasonable wear and tear and unavoidable accidents excepted, and;

WHEREAS: Said party of the second part agrees to pay all electric energy used in the aforementioned concessions;

RESOLUTION NO. 1, 1962

RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER ANNEXATION ESCROW  
FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE  
CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

Since the Civil City of Lebanon is receiving no taxation money from the annexed area as provided in Annexation Ordinance No. 24, dated July 30, 1956, and WHEREAS said ordinance provides for the extension of municipal services to said annexed area, and WHEREAS said ordinance further provides that an amount equal to the amount of taxes collected from said annexed territory shall be receipted to the Annexation Escrow Fund.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Clerk-Treasurer of the Civil City of Lebanon, Indiana be authorized to transfer an amount equal to the proportionate share of the expenses of the administration of the city government as paid from the General Fund in the years 1960 and 1961 from said Annexation Escrow Fund to the General Fund of the Civil City of Lebanon, Indiana. The Clerk-Treasurer also shall be empowered to make annual transfers at the close of succeeding years until such time as the Annexation Escrow Fund is entirely depleted.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
