

Taxpayers appearing at such meeting shall have a right to be heard thereon. The additional appropriations and transfer of appropriations as finally made will be automatically referred to the State Board of Tax Commissioners, which commission will hold a further hearing within fifteen days at the County Auditor's Office of Boone County, Indiana, or at such other place as may be designated. At such hearing taxpayers objecting to any of such additional or transfer of appropriations may be heard and interested taxpayers may inquire of the County Auditor when and where such hearing is to be held.
