

firemen to be employed by said City of Lebanon and other incidental expenses, such as laundry and clothing allowance, and firemen's pension.

It is agreed and mutually understood by and between the parties to this contract that the City of Lebanon shall employ three additional firemen to assist in fighting and extinguishing to the best of their ability the fires occurring in said City and within said Center Township. It is further agreed and mutually understood by and between the parties that the City of Lebanon may use said truck for emergency purposes at any time within the term of this contract.

It is further agreed that this contract shall begin as of this date, to-wit: January 1, 1963 and extend to the 31st day of December, 1964. It is further agreed by and between the parties that this contract shall continue in full force and effect for additional periods of one year by automatic operation unless one party gives notice to the other party of their intention to terminate the contract at the expiration of any year, on or before November 1st.

It is further agreed between these parties that said Center Township shall pay to the City of Lebanon, Indiana, from time to time as they are billed therefor, a sufficient sum of money to pay three additional firemen together with insurance charges as above provided, laundry, clothing allowance and firemen's pension, and that all said charges for employing firemen, for gasing, oiling and repairing said fire truck and for insurance charges, laundry, clothing allowance and firemen's pension for said firemen shall be paid by Center Township as the same are billed therefor by said City.

ORDINANCE NO. 10

Filed - Utilities

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A LEBANON UTILITY BOARD AND PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION AND TERMS OF OFFICE OF THE MEMBERS THEREOF.

SECTION I. Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein; that a Board, which is hereafter to be known as the Lebanon Utility Service Board, consisting of five(5) members, is hereby created, which said Utility Service Board shall operate and manage the Lebanon Water Works Utility, the Lebanon Sewage Plant Utility, and Lebanon Electric Utility.

SECTION II. That the members of the Utility Board shall be resident householders of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, members of which said Board shall be appointed by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and that no more than a majority of whom shall be members of the same political party.

SECTION III. That the compensation of each of the members of the said Utility Service Board shall be three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per year, and shall be paid as follows:

The first quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of each member's salary shall be paid on March 30th, the second quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of each member's salary shall be paid on June 30th, the third quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of each member's salary shall be paid on September 30th, and the remaining quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of each member's salary shall be paid on December 30th of each year, and one quarterly payment shall be made from the Water Works Fund, one quarterly payment shall be made from the Sewage Treatment Plant Fund and the two remaining quarterly payments shall be made from the Electric Utility Fund.
