

SANITARY SEWER CONSTRUCTION RESOLUTION NO. 1

*Filed - Sunnybrook Sewer*

Be it resolved by the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that a necessity exists for the construction of a sanitary sewer in said City at the following location: A 10 inch sanitary sewer to be located in Sunny Brook Addition to the City of Lebanon, beginning 356 feet east of the center line of State Road 39 and to be laid in Sunny Brook Lane a distance of approximately 800 feet.

All work done in the making of said improvement shall be in accordance with the profile, details, drawings and specifications on file in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer of said City, the estimated cost of said improvement, including engineering and inspection costs and the publication of legal notices, occasioned by and incidental to such improvement is \$4900.00, and such improvement is now ordered.

And it is further resolved that the entire cost of said improvement shall be assessed upon the real estate abutting on such sewer to be so constructed, and that said improvement shall be financed and paid for from funds, all according to the method and manner provided for in an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, entitled "An act concerning public improvements in cities, and authorizing cities, except cities of the first class, to create a general improvement fund; and to repeal an act entitled "An act providing for remonstrances by property owners in proceedings for the construction of sidewalks, sewers and for street and alley improvements in cities of the fifth class and in incorporated towns" approved March 6, 1905, as said act pertains to and affects cities of the fifth class, approved February 27, 1953. All proceedings had, and work done in the making of said improvement, assessment of property, and collection of assessments shall be provided for in said above entitled Act and amendments thereto.

RESOLUTION CONFIRMING DECLARATORY SANITARY SEWER CONSTRUCTION RESOLUTION NO. 1, 1963

*Filed - Sunnybrook Sewer*

The Board of Public Works and Safety meets to hear all persons interested in, or whose property is affected by, the following described public improvement: Sanitary Sewer Construction Resolution No. 1, 1963 for the construction of a new sanitary sewer, being a 10 inch sanitary sewer to be located in Sunnybrook Addition to the City of Lebanon, beginning 356 feet east of the center line of State Road 39 and to be laid in Sunnybrook Lane a distance of approximately 800 feet.

After it appearing that notice has been given to all persons interested by publication and mailing, proofs of which are on file, and being sufficiently advised in the premises, the board decides that the benefits to property liable to be affected by said improvements are equal to the estimated cost of the same, as reported by the city civil engineer, and the board takes final action on said resolution as originally adopted, the same being confirmed, without modification.

It is further ordered that the Clerk-Treasurer shall give notice according to law to contractors for the construction of said improvement.
