

In addition therof a temporary working easement of 40 feet in width lying adjacent to and immediately to the west of said above described permanent easement for the purpose of permitting the machinery of the contractor to enter said property and install said sewer which temporary working easement shall cease when construction of said sewer is completed and accepted by the City.

The permanent easement hereby granted is granted to the above named grantee for the purpose of enabling said grantee to keep and maintain an interceptor sewer for its municipal sewer system and supply sewer service to the area through which it passes and it is expressly understood that said sanitary sewer and manholes and all other necessary equipment and fixtures in connection there-with shall at all times be subject to the control, rules and regulations of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and shall at all times be and remain accessible to said City of Lebanon, Indiana, its employees, servants and agents.

It is further understood that said sanitary sewer, manholes and all other necessary equipment and fixtures used or obtained in connection therewith shall be and remain the sole property of the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

ORDINANCE NO. 12, 1963 - ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1964

*Filed - Ordinance Salary*

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

SECTION 1: That the salaries of the following employees of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, beginning January 1, 1964 be as follows:

A. Street Department

Salary of Commissioner - - - - - \$ 95.00 weekly  
Salary of Laborers - - - - - 75.00 weekly

B. Garbage Department

Salary of Driver - - - - - 75.00 weekly  
Salary of Assistants - - - - - 75.00 weekly  
Salary of Bulldozer Operator - - - - - 56.00 weekly

(1) The above weekly rates to apply for a 40 hour week. However, when extreme emergencies arise requiring the above named employees to work more than 40 hours per week as intended, they shall be compensated at the following rates: Street Commissioner, \$2.375 per hour; laborers, \$1.875 per hour. Said overtime shall be allowed only during extreme emergencies occasioned by weather or other unusual conditions; such times to be at the discretion of the Mayor or the City Clerk-Treasurer of the City.

C. Park Department

Salary of Superintendent - - - - - 90.00 weekly  
Salary of Assistant - - - - - 80.00 weekly  
Salary of Laborer - - - - - 75.00 weekly

D. Police Department

Salary of Chief - - - - - 410.00 monthly  
Salary of Night Sergeant - - - - - 370.00 monthly  
Salary of First Class Patrolmen - - - - - 360.00 monthly  
Salary of Second Class Patrolmen - - - - - 350.00 monthly  
Salary of Third Class Patrolmen - - - - - 340.00 monthly  
Salary of Desk Men - - - - - 235.00 monthly
