

WHEREAS, the Lebanon Utility Service Board has funds available to purchase said equipment and dwelling for and on behalf of the City of Lebanon, and,

It is therefore mutually agreed that the City of Lebanon accept the bid of \$6,761.88 from Thrine & Davis, Contractors, for said dwelling, and that the bids for said equipment be accepted in the amount of \$10,261.25, making a total of \$17,023.13, which sum will be paid by the Lebanon Utility Service Board. That the City of Lebanon agrees to pay the sum of \$5500.00 to the Lebanon Utility Service during the year 1963 to be applied on the cost of said dwelling and equipment, and further agrees to pay the sum of \$3250.00 during the year 1964; the sum of \$3000.00 during the years 1965 and 1966; and \$2273.13 during the year 1967 in order to pay and reimburse the Lebanon Utility Service Board for the cost of the above described equipment and dwelling.

AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into by and between the City of Lebanon and Leslie Wilkins, Rural Route # 2, Thorntown, Indiana, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the said Leslie Wilkins is the owner of a semi-trailer Model #NA-1936, Title #P047501, Manufacturer's Identification #BMV 5497, and,

WHEREAS, the said Wilkins desires to operate and maintain said trailer at the City Landfill north of Lebanon, Indiana, on State Road 52, for the accumulation of junk and refuse, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon agrees to furnish a tractor for the towing of said trailer, and,

It is hereby agreed that the City of Lebanon will hold said Wilkins from all liability as a result in the operation of said tractor and trailer in the transfer of said junk and refuse to the point of destination from time to time as the same is transferred to the point of destination. That the City of Lebanon shall not be obligated to pay any rental whatsoever for the use of said trailer, and that the said Wilkins will not be obligated to pay the City of Lebanon any rental for the use of said tractor.
