

ORDINANCE NO. 11 - AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENTS NAMED FOR THE YEAR 1963, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CLERK-TREASURER OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA.

WHEREAS: Certain extraordinary conditions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget for the various functions of City Government, to meet such extraordinary emergencies:

SECTION 1. Be It Ordained By The Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that for the expense of City Government the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and set apart out of the General Fund for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same, such sums herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year, unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided by law.

SECTION 2. That for said fiscal period there is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund, the following specified amounts to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are hereby declared to exist:

EASEMENT FOR SANITARY SEWER

Filed - Easements

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Paul F. Werry and J. Anne Werry, husband and wife, of Boone County, State of Indiana, for and consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and One (1) Sewer Tap, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, to hereby grant unto the City of Lebanon, Boone County, State of Indiana, a right-of-way and easement to lay, install, use, maintain, inspect and repair a sanitary sewer, together with manholes and all other necessary equipment or fixtures used in connection with said sanitary sewer, over and across the following described real estate located in Boone County, State of Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 25, Township 19 North, Range 1 West, described as follows:--Commencing at a point 11.065 chains north of the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of Section 30, Township 19 North, Range 1 East, running thence north 5.52 chains, thence west 16.27 chains to the center-line of State Road 39, thence south 10 degrees east along the center-line of the said Road 3.33 chains, thence east 1.02 chains, thence north 88 degrees 40 minutes east 3.41 chains, thence south 35 degrees east 1.03 chains, thence south 3 degrees east 1.49 chains, thence east 10.585 chains to the place of beginning, containing 7.632 acres, more or less.

A permanent easement of a strip of land sixteen (16) feet in width across the entire width of the above described real estate, to-wit:- The location of said easement to be a distance of eight (8) feet on each side of the center-line of said sanitary sewer as shown on the plans and specifications prepared by Paul Kleiser and Associates, and approved by the Board of Works and Safety, and which are on file in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and which drawings are made a part hereof by reference insofar as is necessary to determine the location of said easement.
