

ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN AMENDMENT TO AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PRODUCTION, TRANSPORTATION, PROCESSING, HANDLING, SAMPLING, EXAMINATION, LABELING, AND SALE OF MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS; THE INSPECTION OF DAIRY HERDS, DAIRIES, AND MILK PLANTS; THE ISSUING AND REVOCATION OF PERMITS TO MILK PRODUCERS, MILK HAULERS, AND DISTRIBUTORS; PERMIT FEES; APPOINTMENT OF INSPECTORS AND SANITARY POLICE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND FIXING PENALTIES.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein, that:

With reference to Section 2 of said Ordinance that said Ordinance is amended with the addition as hereinafter set out after line 21, and which addition reads as follows:

Except ice cream is not to be considered as a milk product as far as this ordinance is concerned.

RESOLUTION NO. 3

A RESOLUTION RENAMING A CERTAIN
STREET IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, IND.

WHEREAS, there exists a street located in the extreme South section of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and;

WHEREAS, said street carries the name of JOHN SHAW ROAD, and;

WHEREAS, residents living on said JOHN SHAW ROAD report that the name is confusing to strangers due to the existence of a road bearing the same name, which road lies entirely outside the limits of the City of Lebanon and having no connection with the above named street, and;

WHEREAS, an access street is now being constructed which connects with said existing street and extending westerly from the West extremity of the existing street to connect with South Lebanon Street in said City, and:

WHEREAS it will be necessary to name the new street;

NOW THEREFORE, the members of the Common Council of Lebanon, Indiana meeting in regular session this 28th day of September 1964, do herein resolve that henceforth said JOHN SHAW ROAD as it now exists, beginning at the Southern extremity of said City and extending North and West, connecting with the newly created street which will terminate at South Lebanon Street, known also as State Road 39 (South) shall be known as BIRCHWOOD DRIVE and said City shall cause signs to be erected accordingly.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
