

RESOLUTION NO. 5RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS IN
THE STREET, FIRE AND RECREATION DEPARTMENTS

WHEREAS: There exists an emergency, requiring certain contractual work to be done at the Landfill by privately owned equipment, and;

WHEREAS: Said work is being performed by John Hendricks with equipment not owned by the City of Lebanon, and;

WHEREAS: Sufficient funds are not available in the Garbage Department account 2-25 GD (Contractual Services, Repairs to Landfill) and;

WHEREAS: There is an unused balance in account 2-26-261 SD (Repairs to Sidewalks), and;

WHEREAS: Both funds affect the General Fund, now therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED: That the sum of \$458.25 be transferred from 2-26-261 SD to 2-25 GD in order that claims be satisfied.

ALSO, BE IT RESOLVED: That the sum of \$11.74 be transferred from 3-33-331 FD to 3-37 FD, and the sum of \$10.74 be transferred from 2-26-261 RD to 2-26-262 RD, both funds affecting the General Fund.

PROPOSAL TO BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS
CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA
FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

We submit, for your consideration, the following proposal outlining a program for the required additions and alterations to the storm sewer system and the replacement and repair of certain bridges serving the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

A. STORM SEWERS:

1. An investigation should be made to determine the condition of the existing storm sewer system.
2. Locate areas that are not being served by these facilities.
3. Locate areas that are not adequately served by these facilities.
4. Prepare an outline for a master storm sewer improvement program.
5. Establish a priority for construction of the proposed improvements.
6. Prepare cost estimates for the various phases of improvement.
7. Determine the most favorable method of financing the work to be performed.
8. Prepare all the above information in report form, including maps, charts and other data.
9. Assist in the development of a public information program.

B. BRIDGES:

1. An investigation should be made to determine the structural condition of the bridges.
2. Further study should be made to determine the adequacy of each bridge in regard to water-way opening, vehicular traffic capacity and pedestrian traffic movement.
3. Select projects to be constructed and establish their respective priorities.
4. Prepare cost estimates for the work to be performed.
5. Determine the most favorable method of financing the work to be performed.
6. Prepare all of the above information in report form, including location maps and sketches.
7. Assist in the development of a public information program.

NOTE:

Our firm made an investigation of the subject bridges and presented a report to the Mayor in the summer of 1964. This report indicates the need for the replacement of five bridges and the repair of a sixth one, estimated construction costs, methods of finance and suggested design.
