The undersigned, Laura E. Roth, Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, hereby certifies that at a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, held in the council chambers in the City Building in said City of Lebanon, Indiana, on the 27th day of July, 1964, the following proceedings were had;

With the Honorable Herbert L. Ransdell, Mayor, presiding, and roll call showed all members of the Common Council present and voting except _____,

Councilman Robert Campbell made the following motion to adopt an ordinance which reads as follows, to wit:

1. "BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, that the real estate as is hereinafter described be annexed to the City of Lebanon, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the East line of said 1/4 Section, Distant 867.85 feet south of the northeast corner thereof; running thence south 0'26'12" West and along said east line 645.95 feet; thence north 89'22' west 870.75 feet to a point 205.78 feet east of the center line of State Road 39 as now established; thence north 33'18'30" west a distance of 383.40 feet; thence north 81'23' west a distance of 52.73 feet to the center line of said State Road 39; thence north 9'53' west and along the center of said road 346.97 feet; thence north 81'15' east 206.78 feet; thence north 8'45' west 23.69 feet; thence north 81'15' east 170 feet; thence south 8'45' east 75 feet; thence south 55'56'10" east 123.78 feet; thence south 89'33'48" east 250 feet; thence south 0'26'12" west 11.09 feet; thence south 89'33'48" east 270 feet; thence north 0'26'12" east 45.26 feet; thence south 89'33'48"
