WHEREAS, The Town of Ulen, Boone County, Indiana, acting through its Board of Trustees and the City of Lebanon, Indiana, acting through its Board of Public Works and Safety desire to enter into a written agreement concerning the City of Lebanon furnishing fire protection to the Town of Ulen subject to the terms and conditions of said agreement, and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, have examined a proposed agreement between the parties for such fire protection and found it to be reasonable and fair to both parties, and

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Lebanon execute said contract agreeing with the Town of Ulen to furnish fire protection according to the terms and conditions as set out in said agreement.
